The specific objective was to improve and streamline bankruptcy procedures in line with International Standards and EU best practices to meet the economic criteria for EU accession. Effective bankruptcy procedures were required to facilitate the exit of inefficient enterprises, recycle assets to more efficient economic use, and encourage banks to lend to the private sector.

The following results were achieved:

- Legal framework improved (assessment of existing legal framework in bankruptcy accomplished; legal recommendations and concrete proposals for amendments of laws elaborated; glossaries to proposed legal amendments were drafted; attention to international principals, legal regulations and directives was paid);
