<p>In the strive for EU accession the Republic of Serbia has reached the status of a candidate country. Within the project "Strengthening Municipal Land Management in Serbia", GIZ supports the Republic of Serbia in the implementation of reforms in areas like titling (ownership of land), use of agricultural land, legal and regulatory framework as well as procedures for a developing land market aiming at a more effective management of agricultural lands. To reach this objective, the project shall implement interventions in three major areas:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Improve the legal and administrative framework according to EU best practice (module 1) 2. Improve management and monitoring procedures for state-owned agricultural land on national and municipal level (module 2) 3. Implement schemes for consolidation of agricultural land and for combating abandonment of agricultural land (module 3) <p>Within the above mentioned module 2, where CLC has contributed so far, an analysis of procedures and processes regarding the management of state-owned agricultural land within the MAFWM / DAL shall identify need for change. Best practice and good examples from EU member states will be made available for comparison and orientation. A focus will be on ownership, change of ownership, registration and use of agricultural land. To improve the monitoring of land use and ownership of state-owned land an appropriate IT-tool will be developed together with key stakeholders from national and local levels. Data collection and processing will inform stakeholder groups and in particular decision makers at the political level.
