<p>The specific objective was to support the Beneficiary in its efforts to improve the knowledge of the practitioners in the field of judicial cooperation (judges, prosecutors, court clerks and specialized personnel working in the Ministry of Justice and the Citizens' Freedoms).</p> <p>The following results were to be achieved:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A manual on judicial cooperation in criminal matters to be used by the practitioners (magistrates members of the Romanian judicial network in criminal matters, staff of the Ministry of Justice and Citizens' Freedoms, judges and prosecutors from all level of jurisdiction, court clerks, representatives from the enforcement bodies) elaborated and disseminated to central and local level. The manual will focus on the most recent EU instruments in the field and will address the specific issues in this area relevant for Romania.
